2017 Local Scholarships Requiring Separate Applications

To apply for the following scholarships, you must complete the applications available in the Main Office. Make sure you meet the scholarship requirements, follow all directions, and complete the applications with all required documentation. Applications must be returned to the main office by **Friday, April 14, 2017** unless indicated otherwise (*). **Note: Scholarship organizations will not consider incomplete applications.**

*Allen and Rosalind <u>Humes Humanitarian Scholarship</u> - Awarded to a <u>Winchester</u> student pursuing a humanitarian discipline (see application for details). **Must return completed application directly to the Foundation by March 31.**

<u>American Legion Gordon Bissell Scholarship</u> - Student must be a high school senior planning to attend an institute of higher learning. Must be a resident of New Hampshire.

<u>American Legion Gordon Bissell Auxiliary Scholarship</u> - Student must be a high school senior planning to attend an institute of higher learning. Must be a resident of New Hampshire.

<u>Andrew Reilly Environmental Stewardship Scholarship</u> – Must be a Keene area high school senior planning a career in the environmental sciences.

*Art Scholarships - Information on art scholarships is available in the Main Office. See Mr. Hyde in the Fine Arts Dept. for questions regarding visual art scholarships.

<u>Chesterfield Lions Club Scholarship</u> – Any graduating high school senior who has been a resident of <u>Chesterfield</u>, <u>Spofford</u>, <u>or West Chesterfield</u> for a minimum of one academic year who plans to attend an accredited college, university, or post-secondary vocational education program.

<u>Chesterfield Scholars Fund Scholarship</u> – Chesterfield, NH resident (Chesterfield, West Chesterfield, or Spofford) who will be a full-time student in liberal arts baccalaureate degree in any field of study at an accredited institution of higher education.

<u>Class of 1971 Roger J. Murphy Memorial Scholarship</u> - Keene High School graduate who will attend a 2-or 4-year college or university and major in engineering, technology, sciences, education, or business. Student must have a B average. Consideration is also based on character, school activity involvement, and community service.

*Davis C. Hemingway Scholarship – Graduating high school student who competed in two sports each year in high school; has been accepted full-time into a four-year accredited institution; must have a minimum GPA of 2.5. See additional requirements on application. Note: Students must send the completed application directly to the Foundation by April 21, 2017.

<u>Fiore Dintino Scholarship</u> – Graduating KHS student who is of Italian ancestry and intends to further their education at a post-secondary institution.

*Frances Strickland – To encourage a deserving person, who has resided in the town of Marlow for at least five years, to continue his/her formal education beyond high school in either an accredited college or technical school located in New Hampshire. Return applications directly to address on application.

*Harry C. Lichman, Class of 1927 Abraham Lincoln Essay Award — KHS seniors must submit an essay (not over 500 words) on any subject relating to the life of Abraham Lincoln. Mr. Lincoln was a source of inspiration to Mr. Lichman and gave him courage to overcome obstacles in order to achieve a career in law. Any essay over 500 words will automatically be disqualified. You must submit a word count with your essay and follow proper citation methods as well as adhere to the school's honor code. The winner must be prepared to read his/her winning essay at Senior Scholarship Awards Night in June. Essays must be submitted to the Principal's Office no later than Friday, March 31, 2017.

<u>Justine Erunski Scholarship</u> - Awarded to a KHS senior who is an active participant on the KHS Varsity Swim Team, with strong work ethic in the class, community, & in the pool with financial need.

KHS Field Hockey Boosters - Must be attending a 2-or 4-year accredited college or tech. school, have a GPA of 2.0, played field hockey for a minimum of three (3) years including senior year. Must submit an essay.

KHS Football Boosters Club - Graduating senior furthering education at a four-year college. Must have played three years football at Keene High School including senior year. G.P.A. must be at least 2.5.

<u>KHS Girls Basketball Leadership Award</u> – Senior must have played at least three years of girls basketball at KHS; minimum GPA of 2.8.

*KHS Health and Human Services Department Scholarship - A KHS student who plans to continue his/her education in Health and Human Services-related post-secondary program. Must have utilized course offerings in the HHS Department at KHS.

<u>Keene Association of Principals (KAPS)</u> - Awarded to a student planning on continuing their education at a post-secondary school. Must have a parent employed by SAU 29.

<u>Keene Education Association Scholarships</u> - One scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who will be <u>majoring in education</u> and who meets academic and financial requirements. A second scholarship will be awarded to a son/daughter of a KEA member who is academically qualified.

*Keene Lodge of Elks #927 Scholarship — Based on academic achievement, participation in worthwhile activities, financial need, and self-help.

Keene Woman's Club Scholarship - Awarded to graduating KHS female senior.

<u>Kiwanis Club of Keene - Charles R. Wilkinson Memorial Scholarship</u> - Graduating KHS senior Key Club member at who is active in the Key Club.

<u>Kiwanis Club of Keene - Robert A. Deverill Medical Scholarship</u> – Graduating KHS student accepted into any certified medical training program; minimum 2.0 GPA.

<u>Ladies Charitable Society Scholarships</u> - Awarded to seniors <u>attending a public New Hampshire college</u> (UNH, Keene State, Plymouth State, Concord Technical Institute, or any of the N.H. community/technical colleges.) These scholarships are intended for students who, without financial assistance, would find it difficult to continue their education. <u>Note the financial aid information you must attach to application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.</u> The scholarships are renewable up to three years.

Marlborough School and Educational Trust Funds - Awarded to residents of Marlborough.

<u>Marlborough PTA Scholarship</u> - Must be a <u>resident of Marlborough</u>. Awarded on the basis of community involvement, cooperative attitude, good work ethic, and the ability to define and show progress towards goals.

<u>Marlborough School Board Financial Aid</u> - <u>Residents of Marlborough</u> should sign for and pick up a letter in the KHS Principal's Office regarding financial aid available to students.

<u>Marlow School Board Scholarship</u> - Awarded to one graduating <u>Marlow senior</u> who is pursuing post-secondary education.

<u>Michael Acerno Scholarship</u> - Awarded to a graduating senior from <u>Westmoreland</u> who will pursue a post secondary education.

*New Hampshire Land Surveyors Foundation -Moran Family Scholarship — NH high school graduating senior who will major in surveying or surveying-related field. (Due March 31 directly to NHLSF.)

Old Homestead Garden Club Scholarship - Awarded to a high school senior interested in environmental studies.

<u>Professional Firefighters Memorial Scholarship</u> - Awarded to a Keene High School graduating senior who will continue in a career in the medical, fire, & ambulance fields & demonstrates good citizenship.

<u>Scores Running Club</u> – To be awarded to a graduating senior who participated in high school track or cross-country for at least two full seasons and who intends to pursue running at a competitive collegiate level.

<u>Stoddard Fire & Rescue – Shannon Sarcione Memorial Scholarship</u> - Available to <u>residents of Stoddard</u> with financial need who display academic excellence, commitment to serving others, and are active in their school and community.

Student Council Scholarships - Available to members of Student Council.

Surry Players Academic Award - Must be N.H. resident pursuing full/part time degree or advanced degree.

<u>Susan T. Sciuto Memorial Scholarship</u> - Awarded to a KHS graduating student who is a <u>resident of Chesterfield</u> with preference to students who will major in <u>science</u> (especially chemistry), education, vocal music, or religion.

<u>Westmoreland Lions Club</u> - Awarded to <u>Westmoreland student</u> planning to attend a two-or four-year accredited college. Applicant must demonstrate good citizenship, have good attendance, & show financial need.

<u>Westmoreland PTA Scholarship</u> - Must be a <u>Westmoreland student</u> and <u>must have attended Westmoreland School at</u> least 3 years.

<u>William Marconi Italian Club Scholarship</u> - Awarded to a needy senior at KHS intending to further his/her education at a post-secondary institution. <u>Parent/grandparent must be a member in good standing of William Marconi Italian Club.</u>

<u>William Marconi Italian Society Scholarship</u> – Awarded to a needy senior at KHS intending to further their education at a post-secondary institution. Parent must be a member in good standing of William Marconi Italian Society.

<u>Winchester Teachers Association Scholarships</u> - Awarded to seniors from <u>Winchester</u>.
