American Association of University Women (AAUW)

Awarded to a KHS female student continuing on to post-secondary education in a 2- or 4-year school who demonstrates high academics.

Archille (Archie) Joyal Scholarship

Awarded annually to a KHS graduating student.

Ball & Wixon Family Scholarship

Awarded to a KHS senior based on academic improvement, community service, and work experience. Interest in stewardship of the environment a plus.

Charles A. Napoli Memorial

Awarded to a KHS senior who has been accepted at an accredited post-secondary school, earned a B average or better or shown continuing improvement in academics, and demonstrated at least one of the following: leadership in school or community organization, volunteer work in community, or co-curricular activities.

Class of 1942 Scholarship

Awarded to a KHS student who demonstrates a willingness to work hard and has a concern for the well-being of the community.

Elwell Family Scholarship

The KHS student shall have contributed to KHS and the community and demonstrates good character.

Edward & Charlotte Kapiloff Insurance
